Directions for the Retreat

To get into town:

If you are coming in by the airport, the 747 bus is an express bus to downtown. It stops along Boul. Rene Levesque as well as Lionel-Groulx Metro, St.-Laurent Metro, and finishes at Berri-UQAM bus/metro station. The fare is 10\$ (please see http://www.stm.info/en/info/networks/bus/shuttle/more-about-747-aeroport-p-e-trudeau-centre-ville-shuttle for more information).

Alternatively, there are many taxi options leaving from the airport which charge a fixed rate (please see http://www.admtl.com/en/access/taxis-limousines for more information).

If you are driving into the city please be aware that there may be disruptions along your route due to construction.

Directions to Thomson House (3650 McTavish)

Please note that there will be no parking near Thomson House. The closest parking is located at the McIntyre Medical Building, which you can reach by driving on Rue Peel or Rue Drummond.

The closest Metro station is Peel. From the Metro station, turn left and walk up Rue Peel. Turn right onto Ave du Docteur-Penfield and walk to Rue MacTavish, turning left up the hill. Thomson House is located on the left side of the street (3650 McTavish).

Due to construction you will not be able to walk directly up McTavish from Sherbrooke.

Directions to the lecture room (Stewart Biology Building room N2/2)


The closest parking is located at the McIntyre Medical Building, which you can reach by driving on Rue Peel or Rue Drummond.

Again, the closest Metro station is Peel. From the Metro station, turn right onto Boul de Maisonneuve and then right onto Rue Stanley. Continue walking up Rue Stanley until you reach Ave. Docteur-Penfield. Across the street from Stanley is the Stewart Biology Building. To find room N2/2, continue straight up the stairs into the courtyard. At the far left of the courtyard is the entry into the North Stewart Biology Building. The lecture room is located just inside these doors. There will be iGluRetreat signs with directions in the courtyard.

Directions to La Prunelle (327 Avenue Duluth E)


Dinner for the 2nd night of the Retreat will be held at La Prunelle Restaurant (327 Avenue Duluth E). There are a number of ways to get there. If you are using public transit, the closest Metro Stations are Sherbrooke Station or Mont-Royal Station (both along the Orange Line). Alternatively, it is about a 30 min walk from the Stewart Biology building and there are a number of routes available to get to the Restaurant. *Some of us will be walking from the Stewart Biology building to La Prunelle and we can set up a rendez-vous point for anyone who would like to follow.*

There are two true seasons in Montreal: Winter and Construction season. We are currently in one of the worst construction seasons in terms of affecting traffic in the city. Please be prepared to adjust your routes as needed. The directions we have provided take street closures into consideration. Walking and public transit are generally safe options but if you are driving, there is a chance that there are delays all around the city.




Google Maps Station Peel, Montréal, QC to La Prunelle
